

American's Housing Per Person Is Increasing

This chart shows us that Sonoma County's population growth rate has been four times the national average. It also shows us that "new home construction is only half driven by population growth. The other half is driven by our expanding levels of housing *consumption*," – increasing the amount of housing space used per person, by building larger houses with fewer people in them.
